Donna Sue Baker | Field Representative U.S. Senator Mitch McConnell



For the past 17 years, Donna Sue Baker has been the Eastern Kentucky Field Representative for United State Senator Mitch McConnell. Donna represents Senator McConnell in the 24 Eastern Kentucky counties including Laurel County. According to Senator McConnell, "As my field representative, Donna is responsible for keeping track of local issues. In a sense, she serves as my eyes and ears when I am unable to be in Kentucky." Donna is the longest serving Eastern Kentucky Field Representative. She interned under Senator McConnell in his London office during the summer of 1987. She has worked under McConnell while he served as the WHIP, Minority Leader and Majority Leader.

Donna has lived and been an active community member in Laurel County since the late 80s. Donna had completed her Bachelor's Degree from Berea College and worked at Laurel Grocery Company while earning her Master's Degree from Eastern Kentucky University. She has also worked for Laurel Heights Home for the Elderly and McKnight Properties prior to working for Senator McConnell. In 1998, Donna was named Laurel County's Woman of the Year.

Donna has served in various capacities as a volunteer for the London-Laurel County Chamber of Commerce including the President's Club from 1990-1998 and then most recently as a Chamber Ambassador. In 2011, Donna was named the Laurel County Chamber Volunteer of the Year. She is currently on the Leadership Tri County Board of Directors, the World Chicken Festival Trustees, a member of the Laurel County Rhubarb Pie Ladies' Group, and represents the Senator on the Cumberland Valley Area Development District Board and the Daniel Boone Community Action Board. She is a member of the Laurel County Republican Women's Forum where she was inducted into their Hall of Fame in 2019. Donna has been named a Kentucky Colonel by several administrations and holds similar titles in her 24 counties.

"Donna plays a key role on my staff, keeping me in close contact with my Eastern Kentucky constituents and providing me with vital insights on her region of the state. Throughout her long career in my office, she has developed deep connections with the leaders she works alongside, fostering positive, productive relationships. I am incredibly grateful for her public service and am proud to have her on my team," said Senator McConnell.

In 1998, when recommending Donna for the Leadership Tri-County class, the late Chamber of Commerce Director Randy Smith wrote "Donna is naturally gifted with a terrific personality and one that offers her the ability to

communicate with anyone she meets...She is career-oriented and self-motivated and not intimidated to set lofty goals that she will work diligently to reach."
