IN THE SPOTLIGHT

Jackson Energy owes its beginnings, like all electric cooperatives, to the passing of legislation that created the Rural Electrification Administration. We were incorporated on July 28, 1938, as Jackson County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation. Our first president was Coleman Reynolds along with 6 other board members. This began the distribution of electricity to rural areas which had previously lacked affordable access. On December 27, 1938, we secured the first funds to build 131 miles of line in Clay, Jackson, Laurel, and Rockcastle counties. By September 14, 1939, we had 380 members that were receiving service. From then until now we changed our name to Jackson Energy Corporation and have grown to more than 52,000 members that span 15 counties!

We have a total of 5,813 miles of line over the total service area. To put that into perspective, our total miles of line could stretch from New York City to Los Angeles and back. We service, build out, and maintain all those miles of line with 116 employees. Having electricity in our homes is a necessity and when the power goes out, we take that very seriously at Jackson Energy. We work in various types of terrain and conditions to restore power as quickly as possible.

We would like to thank all our members across our entire service territory and hope you know that none of this is possible without you! We look forward to seeing everyone at our annual member appreciation days. Details on those days are currently being worked on and will be released soon.
